RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF WILLIAMSTOWN TOWNSHIP POLICE SERVICES TRANSITION

RESOLUTION #10-377

WHEREAS, Ingham County has previously decided to terminate provision of primary police services to the rural townships of Ingham County, effective January 1, 2011, except to such townships who agree to contribute substantially to the cost; and

WHEREAS, Williamstown Township's voters approved a special assessment for such purpose at the election held November 2, 2010; and

WHEREAS, little time remains for resolving the legal, contractual, and political issues inherent in such a change, making immediate action necessary.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, Ingham County declares its willingness to assist Williamstown Township's transition to being primarily responsible for financing its police services by offering a contract including payment of \$122,678 as determined by allocating a portion of the \$800,000 reserved for incentive funding based on a formula using 50% of the 2009 estimated population and 50% of the 2010 taxable value toward the costs of such transition, provided that certain conditions are met.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, such contract shall require Williamstown Township to utilize the County Sheriff's Office.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that such contract shall provide for an adequate level of police services as determined by the Sheriff.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the County expresses its general willingness to enter into similar agreements by December 31, 2011, with any other general law townships within Ingham County, provided they are willing to accept primary responsibility for financing primary police services within their boundaries as indicated by the attached "Ingham County Police Services Incentive Funds Schedule".

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that any final contract will be approved by the Ingham County Board of Commissioners.
